On April 22nd, The City of Topeka and Shawnee County Refuse will haul away large items and trash in neighborhoods highlighted on the map below for FREE!

**APRIL 22ND
RAIN OR SHINE**

Pick up begins at 6 a.m.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

This service is free for the following neighborhoods only:

Tennessee Town, Downtown

Note: Crews will pass through each area only one time to haul away your items. There will be no call backs. The disposal of items after the event date will be the resident's responsibility."

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

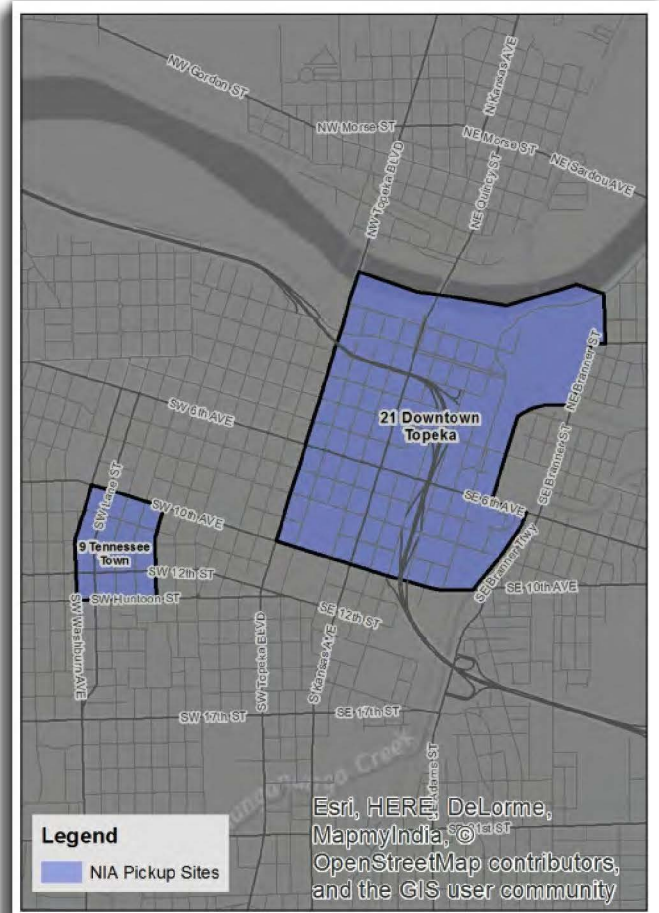
Put large items you want to get rid of out on the curb the night before pickup. (Crews will begin early and you don't want to miss the truck)

WHAT ITEMS CAN NOT BE PICKED UP?

No tires, batteries, concrete or rock rubble, construction or demolition debris, vehicles or any hazardous materials. (No paint, motor oil, insecticides, herbicides, animal waste, etc.) Do NOT mix tree limbs with the trash.

WHAT ABOUT TREE LIMBS?

On the other side of this flyer you can find a coupon for free drop-off of yard waste at the Recycling Facility located at I-70 & MacVicar. ONLY organic materials will be accepted. (No treated lumber, railroad ties, rocks, cement or paper bags.)
