






Project Scope of Work

- Remove and replace deteriorated curb and curb & gutter (in designated areas, deteriorated stone curb will be replaced with square concrete)
- Remove and replace deteriorated storm sewer inlets and pipe
- Relocate selected waterlines
- Sidewalk ramps
- Full depth patching
- Mill and asphalt overlay of all streets

Project Phasing - 2017

This project is going to letting in January 2017. It is anticipated that this will be the order of work.

- Replacement of storm sewer inlets and waterline relocations
- Replacement of curb & gutter and designated sidewalk
- Full depth patching
- Mill and overlay of streets

Project Schedule

The current anticipated schedule for the 2017 project is;

- **January 2017 – Project letting**
- **March/April 2017 – Start work**
- **September 2017 – Project complete**

Anticipated Project Scope of Work

- Remove and replace deteriorated curb and curb & gutter
In designated preservation areas, stone curb will be preserved. In other non-designated areas, deteriorated stone curb will be replaced with square concrete curb.
- Remove and replace deteriorated storm sewer inlets and pipe
- Relocate selected waterlines at intersection
- Sidewalk ramps
- Full depth patching
- Mill and asphalt overlay of all streets except designated brick streets that are to be preserved.

Anticipated Project Schedule

The anticipated schedule for the 2018 project is;

- January 2018 – Project letting
- March/April 2018 – Start work
- September 2018 – Project complete
